Tournament Hours

Official Sunrise: 5:55 AM

Mandatory Pre-launch Meeting: **4:50 AM** Cholla ramp parking lot.

On the water by: 5:20 AM

Start time: **5:35 AM (Safelight)**

Stop time: 3:00 PM

Official tournament hours for purposes of no alcohol consumption are from beginning of tournament briefing until scales are officially closed.

Launch location: Cholla Launch Ramp

Weigh-in location: Cholla Launch Ramp

Creel and length limits: 5 fish limit per team with NO MINIMUM SIZE LIMIT. Alamo is no longer a "Slot Limit" lake.

Off Limits and other lake notes: None known.

Camping:

- a) Fees shown are for a one day/night period. Camping at Cholla, Camp Area 'C'. Cost is \$22 for the 1st vehicle, second vehicle in same camp site is \$15.

- b) Steak barbeque Tuesday night in Area C, hot food served around 5:30 PM area of site C-29.
- c) Poker tournament to follow.

Fishing Teams:

- a) Make sure to agree on how to split pots/winnings prior to start of tournament.
- b) Co-Angler, make sure you contact your boater well in advance of tournament day to make fishing arrangements.
- c) Co-Angler, make sure to pay your boater prior to start of tournament.

General Notes:

- a) Livewell checks will be performed prior to boats being launched at the top of the ramp; please have your live wells open for inspection.
- b) Tournament start will be an **"ooze-off" start**. If you are fishing inside of the No Wake area, you must still start the tournament by idling out pass the Start Boat. You must pass within two boat lengths of the start boat when your number is called. If you do not pass within 30 seconds you can be sent to the end of the line.
- c) Personal Floatation Devices (PFD) must be worn any time main engine is operating with kill switch lanyard secured to the driver. This includes when the Co-Angler is debarking or embarking from the boat if the engine is running. **Each competitor is required to provide their own PFD.**
- d) If you need help launching ask a member or the tournament director prior to the launch.
- e) Please contact tournament director promptly with any cancellations or changes.
- f) Make sure your vehicle is properly permitted.
- g) Must be out of Camp Sites by noon.
- h) Top two citations issued for violations are Fire Extinguisher, Operating your boat in an unsafe manner close to other boats.
- i) Prize Payouts will be made at the next General meeting.
