

LAKE BARTLETT – 15 February 2023 - FACT SHEET

NOTE: THE CO-ANGLER FAIR SHARE FEE TO THEIR BOATER FOR BARTLETT IS \$50

Tournament Hours: THIS IS A REGULAR HOURS TOURNAMENT – Safe Light to 3 PM.

PARKING LOT: 5:00 AM, Side Pot, Load gear, Meet Boater, Backing in lake, Parking

Mandatory Pre-launch Meeting: 5:50 AM Main (Jojoba) ramp parking lot.

Start time: 6:45 AM (Safelight) - - Two Flights (1st Flight includes Weigh-in Crew Members)

Civil Twilight: 6:46 AM Official Sunrise: 7:12 AM

Stop time: 1st Flight (includes Weigh-in Crew Members) 3:00 PM --- 2nd Flight 3:15 PM

Official tournament hours for purposes of no alcohol consumption are from beginning of tournament briefing until scales are officially closed.

Launch location & Headquarters: Main (Jojoba) ramp.

Weigh-in location: Weigh-in will be held in a location designated by the Tournament Director and lake authorities.

Creel and length limits: FIVE FISH (5) limit per team with NO MINIMUM SIZE LIMIT.

Off Limits and other lake notes: No fishing within 100 feet of all ramps, docks, slips, refueling stations, swimming areas, or other Posted areas. Rattlesnake Cove and the Main Marina are off limits. No fishing allowed over any line of buoys designating no entry near a lake's dam or cove. The Tournament Director has final say as to off-limit areas.

Camping: None.

Fishing Teams:

a) Co-Angler, make sure you contact your boater well in advance of tournament day to make fishing arrangements.

b) Co-Angler, make sure to pay your boater prior to start of tournament.

General Notes:

a) Livewell checks will be performed at the top of the ramp prior to boats being launched; please have your live wells open for inspection.

b) Tournament start will be an "ooze-off" start with safe spacing between boats with the Start Boat positioned just inside of the marina tire/buoy line. If you are fishing inside of the No Wake area, you must still start the tournament by idling out pass the Start Boat in single file - in numerical order. You must pass within one boat length of the start boat when your number is called. If a boat number is called to start and is delayed getting to the front of the pack, the next boat in sequence will be allowed to "kick" and the late boat will be inserted in the start line when he reaches the start boat.

c) Personal Floatation Devices (PFD) must be worn any time main engine is operating with kill switch lanyard secured to the driver. This includes when a competitor is debarking or embarking from the boat if the engine is running. Each competitor is required to provide their own PFD.

d) Contact tournament director promptly with any cancellations or changes.

Once the scales are open, the Tournament Director shall distribute the 6-8 official weigh-in bags to teams. These bags are used to regulate the length of the line at the scales, in order to help the health of the fish. After the team weighs in, they are to use a team's personal bag to transport the fish to the lake. The official bags are given to the next team in line. Teams must use a numbered official club bag to bring their fish to the scales. After weigh-in all the fish will be placed back into the angler's personal bag containing water for return to the lake.

Don't crowd Weights Recorder or White Board Recorder in the results area. Safe distance is 6 feet.
