LAKE SAGUARO – 16 AUGUST 2023 - FACT SHEET

NOTE: THE CO-ANGLER SAGUARO FAIR SHARE FEE FOR BOATER IS \$60

Tournament Hours: THIS IS A MODIFIED SUMMER HOURS TOURNAMENT – Safe Light to 11 AM.

Mandatory Pre-launch Meeting: 4:15 AM Ramp # 2 parking lot. MAINTAIN AT LEAST 6 FOOT SAFE DISTANCING AT ALL TIMES IN RAMP PARKING LOT. (Drive past the first ramp and go to the next ramp – you may launch & recover off either ramp 1 or 2).

Official Sunrise: 5:51 AM Civil Twilight: 5:25 AM

Stop time: 1st Flight (includes Weigh-in Crew Members) 11:00 AM / 2nd Flight: 11:15 AM. / 3rd Flight: 11:30 AM
Official tournament hours for purposes of no alcohol consumption are from beginning of tournament briefing until scales are officially closed.

Launch & Headquarters: Lake Saguaro Ramp # 2. For launch as viewed from ramp: Flight 1 to left of ramp – Flight 2 to right.

Weigh-in location: Weigh-in will be held in a location designated by the Tournament Director.

Creel and length limits: THREE (3) fish limit per team with NO MINIMUM SIZE LIMIT.

Off Limits and other lake notes:

- No fishing within 100 ft of boat slips, refueling stations, swimming areas or other posted areas.
- No fishing allowed over any line of buoys designating no entry near a lakes dam or cove.
- You can fish boat launch ramps and adjacent docks. The ramp used by the tournament is off limits the last hour before weigh-in.
- You can fish marina walkways as long as you are 100 ft from any boat slips and refueling stations.
- You can fish water inside tires and behind marinas as long as you are 100 ft from any boat slips and refueling stations.

Fishing Teams:

Co-Angler, make sure you contact your boater well in advance of tournament day to make fishing arrangements.

Co-Angler, make sure to pay your boater prior to start of tournament.

General Notes:

Livewell checks MAY be performed prior to boats being launched at the top of the ramp; please have your live wells open for inspection.

Personal Floatation Devices (PFD) must be worn any time main engine is operating with kill switch lanyard secured to the driver. This includes when a competitor is debarking or embarking from the boat if the engine is running. **Each competitor is required to provide their own PFD.**

Contact tournament director promptly with any cancellations or changes.

Vehicles without boat trailers park only in single vehicle spaces.

Once the scales are open, the Tournament Director shall distribute the 6-8 official weigh-in bags to teams.

These bags are used to regulate the length of the line at the scales, in order to help the health of the fish.

After the team weighs in, they are to use a team's personal bag to transport the fish to the lake. The official bags are given to the next team in line. Teams must use a numbered official club bag to bring their fish to the scales. After weigh-in all the fish will be placed back into the angler's personal bag containing water for return to the lake.
