The club retains all forfeited entry fees. Once all non-boaters are paired, remaining boaters that have not been paired with a non-boater will be allowed to choose to either fish alone or to be paired with another boater. Solo boaters will only be responsible for their personal entry fees. Payouts will be based on the number of boats fishing; a boat is based on two persons. If two solo boats are fishing they will only count as one boat. A single solo boat will not be counted in the number of boats paid out.
